



BNSUD CLINIC/ TRAINING SCHEDULE CHANGE

With the recent changes being made by Public Health regarding Group Gatherings, Staying close to Home and the loss of several clinic facilities in many areas of the Province, at this time the BNSUD Board has made the decision to postpone/ reschedule the in-person sessions that had been scheduled between May 1st and May 16th. We remain hopeful that some sessions currently scheduled in late May and early June may still be able to be held.

To ensure you are able to have the information, we have decided that we will make available an online module that will review the positioning for our modified 2 umpire positioning for 2021. We will be advising to all when the online positioning module is available to take through your BNSUD profile. The expectation will be that everyone reviews all the online modules.

At this time, we will be planning 2 ZOOM sessions for any umpires who are interested – we may add more based on need and instructor availability. The ZOOM sessions will be mandatory for any NEW umpires. We will be emailing the NEW umpires advising them of the schedule for the ZOOM sessions. For your information:

May 8th – 9am to approximately 11am

May 15th - 9am to approximately 11am

We will be removing the previously scheduled clinics so you can register for your ZOOM session which will be set up as a ZOOM online clinic through the Clinics tab on your BNSUD Profile. Priority will be given to new or returning Level 1 umpires.

As a reminder, the current schedule will be fluid. We will be adjusting as necessary as we will not be taking any unnecessary risks and we will be following the Public Health guidelines regarding Group Gatherings indoor vs outdoor and travel limitations.
